

The Wallace Barnes Nature Trail

A free universally accessible Nature Trail is found at the Barnes Memorial Nature Center. This 1.1 mile almost level trail is accessible to people using wheelchairs, strollers, walkers, and other mobility devices. The trail is a combination of crushed stone and boardwalk which never gets muddy. The trail has lots of shade, a bunch of benches, a shelter by a stream, and a shelter by an open field. It also has a dozen signs explaining the local geology, history, flora, and fauna. Parking is in front of the Barnes Nature Center located at 175 Shrub Road, Bristol CT.
